

## **SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION**

### **SB 546**

#### **Relating to chemicals used in cosmetic products**

SB 546 requires the Oregon Health Authority to establish, by rule, a list of high priority chemicals of concern used in cosmetic products.

The measure requires manufacturers selling or distributing cosmetics with more than trace amounts of the high priority chemicals to post a notice on their website to Oregon residents.

Manufacturers are prohibited from distributing or selling cosmetics with certain chemicals.

OHA may impose civil penalties on manufacturers who fail to meet the requirements of the measure.

The measure is effective January 1, 2027.

The Human Services Subcommittee recommends SB 546 be reported out do pass.
