

SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

SB 1041

Relating to health insurance coverage of breast examinations

To: Ways and Means Full Committee
From: Human Services Subcommittee
Carrier: Senator Campos

SB 1041 prohibits group health benefit plans and individual health benefit plans in Oregon from charging a deductible, coinsurance, copayment or other out of pocket expenses for medically necessary supplemental or diagnostic breast exams. The list of required services that health benefit plans must cover will change, impacting the premiums for the employee health plans offered by the Public Employees' Benefit Board and the Oregon Educators Benefit Board by an estimated \$1.4 million Other Funds in 2023-25.

The Human Services Subcommittee recommends SB 1041 be reported out do pass.
