SB 1049 is a non-appropriation measure that makes necessary changes in statutes and session law to support the 2023-25 legislatively adopted budget, to clarify the application of statutes for the budget, and modify provisions relating to the use of funds. Specifically, the measure:

- Removes outdated statutory requirements for various agencies to report to the Emergency Board when adopting new fees,
- Transfers \$40 million from the Public Employees' Benefit Board Revolving Fund to the General Fund and \$50 million to the DAS Risk Insurance Fund,
- Establishes three new Funds,
- Changes the maximum allowed number of state employees to 1.5% of the state's population of the prior year,
- Increases the student vision screening reimbursement rate to \$4 per student,
- Extends the sunsets on the Tide Gate Grant Program and wildfire risk reduction projects, and
- Repeals 2013 Oregon Chapter Laws related to the previous Interstate 5 bridge replacement project.

The Capital Construction Subcommittee recommends SB 1049 be amended by the -2 amendment and be reported out do pass, as amended.
