**Measure Description:**

Increases statute of limitations for first degree sex crimes to 20 years after commission of crime or, for minor victim, any time before victim attains 30 years of age, whichever occurs later.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Counties, Department of Corrections, District Attorneys, Oregon Youth Authority, Criminal Justice Commission, Department of Justice, Cities, Judicial Department, Public Defense Services Commission

**Analysis:**
