Wage Theft Protection for Construction Workers in Oregon

Wage theft affects millions of workers across the country and exacerbates income inequality. By addressing this issue head-on, we can create a fairer labor market and promote economic growth.

Streamlines the wage claim process: HB 2057 is crucial because it aims to streamline the wage claim process for contractors and employees in the construction industry. The bill encourages internal resolution of wage disputes or through joint labor-management committees, which leads to timely and cost-effective settlements.

Protect vulnerable workers: Low-wage workers, immigrants, and young workers are often the primary victims of wage theft. Our bill will provide these groups with the protection they need, ensuring their rights are upheld.
