**Measure Description:**

Grants certain immunities to children's advocacy centers and to employees and designated agents of children's advocacy centers.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Judicial Department, Department of Justice, Counties

**Analysis:**

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Early Childhood and Human Services to the House Committee on Judiciary.

The measure provides immunity from civil liability and judicial proceedings resulting from participation in child abuse assessments to employees and designated agents of children’s advocacy centers. Requires proof of good standing or progress towards accreditation by a national organization when applying for funds to establish and/or maintain a children’s advocacy center.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the House Committee on Judiciary.
