Measure Description:

Authorizes State Fish and Wildlife Commission to establish by rule requirements or prohibitions concerning angling, taking, hunting, trapping or possessing of wildlife defined as predatory animal.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Energy and Environment to the Senate Desk for rereferral to another committee.

The measure authorizes the State Fish and Wildlife Commission to establish rules relating to wildlife deemed as predatory animals.
