Authorizes State Fish and Wildlife Commission to establish by rule requirements or prohibitions concerning angling, taking, hunting, trapping, or possessing of wildlife defined as predatory animal.

BACKGROUND:

The Oregon Fish and Wildlife Commission was formed July 1, 1975 when the formerly separate fish and wildlife commissions were merged. Commissioners formulate general state programs and policies concerning management and conservation of fish and wildlife resources and establish seasons, methods, and bag limits for recreational and commercial take.
