SUMMARY

Updates and modernizes statutes that regulate practice of architecture in this state to conform with actual current practice of architecture.

OPEN GOVERNMENT IMPACT

Legislative Counsel has not adopted standards for drafting measures that establish exemptions from disclosure of public records.

This measure exempts from public disclosure information the State Board of Architect Examiners obtains or receives in an investigation related to the practice of architecture unless the public interest requires disclosure.

If those public records that could be subject to public disclosure were instead subject to mandatory disclosure under public records law, the public could gain information related to ongoing and completed investigations by the board related to the practice of architecture.
