SUMMARY

Repeals Interstate Compact on the Placement of Children. Enacts Interstate Compact for the Placement of Children.

OPEN GOVERNMENT IMPACT

Legislative Counsel has not adopted standards for drafting measures that establish exemptions from disclosure of public records.

This measure allows the Interstate Commission for the Placement of Children to exempt from public disclosure information or official records to the extent that they would adversely affect personal privacy rights or proprietary interest.

If the public records were instead subject to mandatory disclosure under public records law, the public could receive information about children whose care is being arranged by a public or private child placing agency, information regarding the placement of those children in homes or facilities, and information relating to the homes, facilities and agencies involved in caring for or placing the children.
