### SUMMARY

Prohibits Secretary of State and county clerks from disclosing as public record, or including on lists of electors, residence address of elector who is candidate for elected office or holder of elected office.

Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

### OPEN GOVERNMENT IMPACT

Legislative Counsel has not adopted standards for drafting measures that establish exemptions from disclosure of public records.

This measure prohibits the public disclosure by the Secretary of State or a county clerk of the residential address of an elector who is either a candidate for elected office or a holder of elected office.

Those public records are currently subject to mandatory public disclosure.
