SUMMARY

Exempts from public disclosure personal information of employees and retirees maintained by retirement system operated by local government. Clarifies that personal information of employees and volunteers of public body is exempt from disclosure regardless of record in which information is maintained.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

OPEN GOVERNMENT IMPACT

Legislative Counsel has not adopted standards for drafting measures that establish exemptions from disclosure of public records.

This measure extends the exemption from public disclosure of employee and retiree address, telephone number and other nonfinancial membership and employee financial records maintained by the Public Employees Retirement System to include other retirement systems operated by a public body.

If those public records that could be subject to public disclosure were instead subject to mandatory disclosure under public records law, the public could receive information regarding participation in retirement systems operated by public bodies.
