Measure Description:

Establishes Task Force on Organized Retail Theft.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Task Force/Committee/Workgroup, Legislative Assembly, Department of Justice

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Labor and Business to the Senate Committee on Judiciary.

The measure establishes the five-member Task Force on Organized Retail Theft. The Task Force includes five members of the public, with two appointed by the President of the Senate, two appointed by the Speaker of the House, and one appointed by the Attorney General. The Task Force is to review existing issues of organized retail theft and determine changes to laws or policies that may address those issues or reduce organized retail theft. The Department of Justice is to provide staff support to the Task Force. Members are not entitled to compensation or reimbursement; and the Task Force sunsets December 31, 2024.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Senate Committee on Judiciary.
