SUMMARY

Directs county clerk to keep residence address of elector exempt from disclosure as public record if elector is education board member.

Establishes that crime of harassment or aggravated harassment includes harassment against education board member. Punishes by maximum of five years' imprisonment, \$125,000 fine, or both.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

OPEN GOVERNMENT IMPACT

Legislative Counsel has not adopted standards for drafting measures that establish exemptions from disclosure of public records.

This measure expands the exemption from public disclosure of certain residential addresses to include residential addresses of education board members.

If those public records that could be subject to public disclosure were instead subject to mandatory disclosure under public records law, the public could receive residential addresses of education board members.
