**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:**

Prohibits sale, offer for sale or trade of fur product in State of Oregon. “Fur product” does not include animal skin to be converted into leather, cowhide, deerskin, lambskin or sheepskin or taxidermy. Punishable by maximum of 364 days’ imprisonment, \$6,250 fine, or both. Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.
