Measure Description:

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to State Forestry Department for purposes related to plant disease Sudden Oak Death.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Agriculture, Counties, Department of Forestry

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Natural Resources to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure appropriates \$3,060,951 General Fund to the Oregon Department of Forestry to carry out an integrated pest management program to combat Sudden Oak Death. Of these funds, \$50,000 is to be expended as a block grant to assist the Association of Oregon Counties to establish and operate a task force to encourage and coordinate county programs to combat Sudden Oak Death. The measure declares an emergency and takes effect on passage.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
