### **Measure Description:**

Exempts hybrid motor vehicles and motor vehicles with model years that predate by six years or less date of registration or renewal of registration from requirement to be equipped with certified pollution control system.

## **Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Department of Transportation, Cities, Counties, Judicial Department

#### **Analysis:**

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Energy and Environment to the Joint Committee on Transportation.

The measure exempts hybrid motor vehicles that use electricity or another source of motive power and, any motor vehicles with model years that predate the year in which registration or renewal of registration is required by six years or less from requirement to be equipped with certified pollution control system. The measure is effective January 1, 2025.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in Joint Committee on Transportation.
