**Measure Description:**

Requires that cosmetology curriculum taught by school meet standards established by Board of Cosmetology and be approved by Health Licensing Office.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Community Colleges, Department of Education, Higher Education Coordinating Commission, Oregon Health Authority, School Districts

**Analysis:**
