Measure Description:

Requires Bureau of Labor and Industries, in consultation with Employment Department to conduct study that identifies apprenticeship opportunities in this state and evaluates best practices for keeping up-to-date list of available opportunities on webpages of bureau and department.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Bureau of Labor and Industries, Employment Department

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Labor and Business to the Senate Committee on Rules.

The measure requires the Bureau of Labor and Industries, in consultation with Employment Department, to conduct a study that identifies apprenticeship opportunities, ranked in order of the industries and occupations with the greatest need for a skilled workforce. The measure requires the Employment Department and Bureau of Labor and Industries to post up to date list of available apprenticeship opportunities and to report to the Legislative Assembly by September 15, 2024.
