Measure Description:

Modifies definitions related to child care for purposes of implementation and enforcement. Grants discretion to the Department of Early Learning and Care (DELIC) to organize itself into administrative divisions and modifies definitions and provisions relating to regulation of child care providers by DELIC.

Analysis:
