Measure Description:

Requires Oregon Liquor and Cannabis Commission to require applicant for cannabis-related license or license renewal to submit signed attestation that applicant will refrain from interfering with labor organizing efforts or submit attestation that applicant and labor organization that is certified to represent employees of applicant have entered into and will abide by terms of labor peace agreement.

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Labor and Business to the House Committee on Rules.

The measure requires the Oregon Liquor and Cannabis Commission to require an applicant for a cannabis-related license or license renewal to submit an attestation that applicants will not interfere with labor organizing efforts.
