Measure Description:

Directs court clerk to provide, upon request, certified copy of any record available on electronic records management system of Judicial Department.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Justice, District Attorneys, Public Defense Services Commission, Cities, Counties, Judicial Department

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Judiciary to the House Committee on Rules.

The measure requires court clerks or administrators to provide any person who requests a certified copy of a record, that is in custody of the court clerk or administrator, an electronic copy through an electronic records management system of the Oregon Judicial Department. The measure also allows a witness who is testifying for a probation violation to appear simultaneously through an electronic transmission without written consent from the opposing party or court.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the House Committee on Rules.
