**Measure Description:**

Creates Deadly Force Prosecutions Unit within Criminal Justice Division of Department of Justice.

**Analysis:**

The measure appropriates an unspecified amount of General Fund to the Department of Justice (DOJ) for establishing the Deadly Force Prosecutions Unit within the Criminal Justice Division. The Deadly Force Prosecutions Unit is designed to specialize in the investigation and prosecution of cases involving law enforcement use of force that results in deaths. The measure is effective January 1, 2024.

Department of Justice

DOJ reports that two Senior Assistant Attorney General positions (1.50 FTE), one Criminal Investigator (0.75 FTE), and one Paralegal (0.75 FTE) would be necessary for establishing the specialized unit. DOJ estimates the cost for these positions and service and supplies will be \$1.2 million General Fund for the 2023-25 biennium. The Legislative Fiscal Office notes that the measure provides funding on a one-time basis therefore, the fiscal impact statement assumes costs will only be incurred in the 2023-25 biennium.

This measure has a subsequent referral to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means for consideration of its budgetary impact on the State's General Fund.
