Measure Description:

Establishes the Oregon Housing Justice Program and appropriates \$35.6 million General Fund to the Housing and Community Services Department.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Housing and Community Services Department

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Housing and Development to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure establishes the Oregon Housing Justice Program and appropriates \$35.6 million General Fund to the Housing and Community Services Department. Of this amount, \$100,000 is for grants to culturally specific and responsive organizations, \$14 million is to provide grants to the Oregon Worker Relief Coalition, \$10.5 million is for grants to the Urban League of Portland, \$1.5 million is for a grant to the Immigrant and Refugee Community Organization, and \$9.5 million is for a grant to community action agencies for grants. The measure also authorizes the Housing and Community Services Department to develop a policy to allow stipends for task force members with lived experience of housing instability or homelessness.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
