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Measure Description:

Requires Department of Human Services to request from Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services approval of waiver to obtain federal financial participation in costs of program to pay parents of minor children with disabilities to provide attendant care services to children.

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Health Care to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure replaces the introduced version. The measure directs the Department of Human Services to compensate parent providers of children who have very high needs or children who have extraordinary physical, mental, or emotional needs as determined by the child’s health care provider. The measure describes eligibility requirements and exceptions.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

Further Analysis Required
