Measure Description:

Establishes the Nonviolent Crisis Intervention and Safe Communities Fund and the Safe School Culture Grant program.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Human Services, Department of Education

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Human Services to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure replaces the introduced version. The measure establishes the Nonviolent Crisis Intervention and Safe Communities Fund and directs the Department of Education to transfer \$4 million to the fund to pay grants for the Safe School Culture Grant program. Funds in the Nonviolent Crisis Intervention and Safe Communities Fund are continuously appropriated to the Department of Human Services. The measure declares an emergency and is effective on passage.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
