Measure Description:

Permits home care agencies to petition the Oregon Health Authority to conduct their own training subject to approval.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Oregon Health Authority, Department of Human Services

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Early Childhood and Human Services to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure replaces the introduced version. The measure directs the Oregon Health Authority to permit in-home care agencies to conduct their own training for employees and contractors subject to the provisions in the bill.
