

FISCAL IMPACT OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION

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Measure Description:

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon Health Authority to be used for specified purposes related to expanding behavioral health provider workforce.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Oregon Health Authority

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Behavioral Health and Health Care to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure appropriates General Fund to the Oregon Health Authority:

- \$30 million to deposit into the Behavioral Health Incentive Subaccount
- \$30 million to expend to counties for the purposes defined in ORS 675.655(2)
- \$1 million for outreach efforts
- \$14 million to be divided between county mental health programs and private practitioners

The measure takes effect July 1, 2023.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

Further Analysis Required
