Measure Description:

Requires Bureau of Labor and Industries to study issues relating to different leave laws under which individuals may take time off of work for qualifying reasons.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Bureau of Labor and Industries, Employment Department

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Labor and Business to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The -3 amendment replaces the original measure and expands who may qualify as a family member for the purposes of the Oregon Family Leave Act (OFLA) and the Paid Leave Oregon program. The measure also clarifies reinstatement provisions after returning from leave and clarifies employer contributions related to insurance. The measure will have a General Fund impact on BOLI.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
