**Measure Description:**

Directs Department of Education to develop and implement a statewide education plan. Requires each qualified school district to establish a special education advisory council.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Department of Education, School Districts, Higher Education Coordinating Commission, Department of Early Learning and Care, Confederated Tribes of Grand Ronde, Confederated Tribes of Siletz, Confederated Tribes of Warm Springs, Burns Paiute Tribe, Confederated Tribes of Coos, Lower Umpqua and Siuslaw Indians, Confederated Tribes of Umatilla Indian Reservation, Coquille Indian Tribe, Cow Creek Band of Umpqua Indians, Klamath Tribes

**Analysis:**

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Education to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure directs the Oregon Department of Education (ODE) to develop and implement a statewide education plan for plan students. The measure requires ODE, in consultation with the specified advisory group, to award grants to Early Learning Hubs, providers of early learning services, school districts, education service districts, post-secondary institutions of education, tribal governments, community-based organizations, or a consortium of these entities, to implement the strategies provided in the plan.

In addition, the measure directs each qualified school district to establish a special education advisory council. ODE is required to provide basic guidelines and forms to assist school districts in establishing and administering the advisory council and requires each advisory council, no later than June 30 of each year, to prepare a report on specified topics. School districts shall convene an advisory council by February 1, 2024.

The measure declares an emergency, effective upon passage.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
