Measure Description:

Establishes Task Force on High School Transcripts.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Task Force/Committee/Workgroup, Department of Education, School Districts, Higher Education Coordinating Commission

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Education to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure directs the Oregon Department of Education (ODE) to collect course-level completion and grade data for public school students in grades 6 through 12.

The measure also creates the 18-member Task Force on High School Transcripts which is to develop recommendations for streamlining the transfer of course completion data, and to consider issues related to transcripts and grades for high school age students. The task force is to report to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to education no later than September 15, 2024. Members of the task force are not entitled to compensation or reimbursement for expenses and serve as volunteers on the task force. The bill directs the Higher Education Coordinating Commission, with any needed assistance from ODE, to provide staff support for the task force. The task force sunsets on December 31, 2024.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
