Measure Description:

Requires the Department of Human Services to provide financial support to nonprofit organizations providing affordable housing support to low-income college students.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Housing and Community Services Department, Department of Human Services

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Housing and Homelessness to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure directs the Department of Human Services to provide financial support to nonprofit organizations providing affordable housing support to low-income college students in accordance with the Department’s self-sufficiency programs and appropriates \$5 million General Fund to DHS for grants to eligible nonprofits that provide affordable housing support to low-income college students. The -3 amendment changes the sunset date to January 2, 2026.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
