Measure Description:

Creates process by which person may file post-conviction relief petition due to currently available relevant forensic scientific evidence at any time after conviction.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Counties, District Attorneys, Public Defense Services Commission, Department of Justice, Judicial Department

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Judiciary to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure allows a person convicted of a crime to file a petition for post-conviction relief based on currently available forensic scientific evidence any time after entry of the judgment of conviction. The measure provides the specific circumstances that the court may or, may not deny relief. The measure effective January 1, 2024.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
