SUMMARY

Requires Oregon Health Authority to develop, implement and administer program to support consumer engagement efforts aimed at increasing and optimizing consumer involvement in planning and decision-making surrounding the access to, and the delivery of, behavioral health services in this state. Directs authority to enter into contracts with consumer supporter technical assistance center to provide technical and financial assistance in carrying out activities that accomplish purpose of program.

Requires consumer supporter technical assistance center that contracts with authority to submit annual progress report to authority.

Modifies definition of "consumer" for purposes of Consumer Advisory Council.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.
