Measure Description:

Modifies process for setting aside convictions and guilty except for insanity judgments.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Board of Parole and Post-Prison Supervision, District Attorneys, Public Defense Services Commission, Judicial Department, Department of Justice

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Judiciary to the Senate Committee on Rules.

The measure expands the procedure and eligibility of people who may file a motion to set aside convictions, arrests, citations, or charges, however, traffic violations are not eligible and requires the court to issue the order to set aside within 30 days. There measure authorizes courts, as part of entering an order, to waive any remaining fines and fees owed by the person on the conviction. The measure is effective on the 91st day after sine die.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Senate Committee on Rules.
