#### WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Directs the Oregon Criminal Justice Commission to classify the crime of felon in possession of a firearm as a crime category 8 of the sentencing guidelines grid. Exempts those who are protected under the Address Confidentiality Program from the background check and permit requirement for a firearm transfer. Applies to firearm transfers occurring on or after the effective date of the measure.

#### **ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- Whether someone will be charged with a crime if they obtain a large capacity magazine after December 8, 2022
- How the Oregon State Police communicate with the permit agent and permit holder regarding qualification and disqualification

#### **EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:**

Replaces the measure.
