Measure Description:

Clarifies meaning of "one-year period" for purposes of determining amount of unpaid family leave that eligible employee is entitled to take within any given one-year period; specifies relationships that qualify as family members for purposes of family leave; modifies provisions relating to job sites for employees returning to work; specifies utilization of family or medical leave in relation to the Family and Medical Leave Act; and allows for insurance deductions by employers under certain circumstances.
