## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Requires Department of Transportation to study development of uniform standards for speed bump height and markings. Sunsets January 2, 2025.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to transportation.

**3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:** 

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The Department of Transportation shall conduct a study of speed bumps

5 to examine the possibility of developing uniform standards for speed bump height and speed

6 bump markings and shall make a report on its findings.

7 (2) The department shall submit the report required by subsection (1) of this section, and

8 may include recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative

- 9 Assembly related to transportation in the manner provided under ORS 192.245 no later than
- 10 September 15, 2024.
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2023 Act is repealed on January 2, 2025.
