

House Bill 2175

Sponsored by Representatives SMITH DB, WRIGHT (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Appropriates moneys to Department of Education for distribution to certain school districts for certain career and technical education programs.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2023.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to funding for career and technical education programs; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**
5 **ated to the Department of Education, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, out of the**
6 **General Fund, the amount of \$250,000, which shall be distributed by the department, based**
7 **on calculations made under ORS 327.859, to school districts to use on existing career and**
8 **technical education programs if the school district:**

9 (1) **Has a high school that is a remote small high school, as determined by the depart-**
10 **ment; and**

11 (2) **Demonstrates how the existing career and technical education programs satisfy el-**
12 **igibility requirements for moneys received under ORS 327.853 to 327.895 and how the estab-**
13 **lishment or expansion of career and technical education programs would not satisfy**
14 **eligibility requirements under ORS 327.853 to 327.895.**

15 **SECTION 2. This 2023 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
16 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2023 Act takes effect**
17 **July 1, 2023.**
