## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Department of Justice to study child support enforcement. Directs department to submit findings to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to judiciary not later than September 15, 2024.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to child support.

**3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:** 

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> The Department of Justice shall study child support enforcement. The de-

5 partment shall submit a report in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, and may include

6 recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly re-

7 lated to judiciary no later than September 15, 2024.

- 8 <u>SECTION 2.</u> Section 1 of this 2023 Act is repealed on January 2, 2025.
