1	Delete lines 4 through 21 of the printed bill and insert:
2	"SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-
3	priated to the Department of Justice, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, out of the
4	General Fund, the amount of \$25,400,000, which may be expended for the purpose of funding
5	county victim assistance programs in accordance with the distribution schedule set forth in
6	section 2 of this 2023 Act.
7	"SECTION 2. (1) The Department of Justice shall distribute moneys appropriated to the
8	department under section 1 of this 2023 Act in accordance with the following schedule:
9	"(a) For every four full-time equivalent prosecuting attorneys serving in a county district

attorney office, the department shall distribute an amount sufficient to fund one victim assistance advocate position in the county district attorney office; or

"(b) If fewer than four full-time equivalent prosecuting attorneys serve in the county

"(b) If fewer than four full-time equivalent prosecuting attorneys serve in the county district attorney office, the department shall distribute an amount sufficient to fund one victim assistance advocate.

"(2) Amounts distributed under this section shall be equal biennial amounts for each full-time equivalent victim assistance advocate being funded.

"(3) Amounts that are unexpended as of June 30, 2025, shall revert to the General Fund. "SECTION 3. This 2023 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2023 regular session of the Eighty-second Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.".

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
