

# House Bill 2393

Sponsored by Representative DEXTER (Pre-session filed.)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Higher Education Coordinating Commission to conduct study to determine how to best address food insecurity for students enrolled in post-secondary institutions of education in this state. Directs commission to submit findings to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to higher education not later than September 15, 2024.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to post-secondary student food insecurity.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. The Higher Education Coordinating Commission shall conduct a study to**  
5 **determine how to best address food insecurity for students enrolled in post-secondary insti-**  
6 **tutions of education in this state. The commission shall submit a report in the manner pro-**  
7 **vided by ORS 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation, to the interim**  
8 **committees of the Legislative Assembly related to higher education no later than September**  
9 **15, 2024.**

10 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2023 Act is repealed on January 2, 2025.**
