House Bill 2395

SUMMARY

Requires Oregon Health Authority to study substance use. Directs authority to submit findings to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to health care not later than September 15, 2024.

3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. The Oregon Health Authority shall study substance use in this state. The
5	authority shall submit a report in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, and may include
6	recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly re
7	lated to health care no later than September 15, 2024.
8	SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2023 Act is repealed on January 2, 2025.
