

House Bill 2397

Sponsored by Representative DEXTER (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Oregon Health Authority to study opioid overdose prevention. Directs authority to submit findings to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to health care not later than September 15, 2024.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to opioid overdose prevention.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. The Oregon Health Authority shall study opioid overdose prevention. The**
5 **authority shall submit a report in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, and may include**
6 **recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly re-**
7 **lated to health care no later than September 15, 2024.**

8 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2023 Act is repealed on January 2, 2025.**
