

House Bill 2682

Sponsored by Representative NERON (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs State Apprenticeship and Training Council to develop and implement registered apprenticeship program to create pathway to licensure for teacher candidates.

2 Relating to teacher apprenticeship programs.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2023 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 660.002 to**
5 **660.210.**

6 **SECTION 2. (1) The State Apprenticeship and Training Council shall develop and imple-**
7 **ment a registered apprenticeship program to create a pathway to licensure for teacher can-**
8 **didates.**

9 **(2) The program shall be developed in collaboration with representatives of the following:**

10 **(a) The Teacher Standards and Practices Commission;**

11 **(b) The Department of Education;**

12 **(c) Office of Community Colleges and Workforce Development;**

13 **(d) The Bureau of Labor and Industries;**

14 **(e) The Educator Advancement Council;**

15 **(f) A professional organization that represents licensed school employees; and**

16 **(g) A professional organization that represents classified school employees.**
