

House Bill 2710

Sponsored by Representatives VALDERRAMA, RUIZ (at the request of Amanda Manjarrez) (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires school districts to file with Superintendent of Public Instruction information about allocations and expenditures of moneys received from State School Fund. Directs Department of Education to make information describing allocations and expenditures of moneys available on department's website.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to district use of State School Fund moneys; amending ORS 327.133.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 327.133 is amended to read:

5 327.133. (1)(a) Except as provided in paragraph (b) of this subsection, each school district, other
6 than an education service district, shall file with the Superintendent of Public Instruction:

7 *[(A) By July 15 of each year, an annual report covering the school year ending on the preceding*
8 *June 30; and]*

9 *[(B)]* **(A)** By January 15[,] of each year, a December quarterly report covering the quarter of the
10 current school year commencing October 1 and ending December 31[.];

11 **(B) By July 15 of each year, an annual report covering the school year ending on the**
12 **preceding June 30; and**

13 **(C) By September 1 of each year, a description of the allocations and expenditures of**
14 **moneys received under ORS 327.006 to 327.133, 327.348, 327.356 to 327.359, 327.731, 328.542 and**
15 **530.115 using uniform definitions provided by the uniform budget and accounting system un-**
16 **der ORS 327.511.**

17 (b) Pursuant to rules adopted by the State Board of Education, the Superintendent of Public
18 Instruction may waive a reporting date or specify an alternative date for filing a report if a
19 human-created disaster or a natural disaster affects the ability of the school district to file a report
20 by the specified date.

21 (2) Each such report shall show the average daily membership of resident pupils of the school
22 district for the period covered and shall also contain such other information as the Superintendent
23 of Public Instruction may require.

24 **(3) The Department of Education shall make information received under subsection**
25 **(1)(a)(C) of this section available on the department's website in a manner that makes the**
26 **information transparent, uniform and readily accessible.**
