CHAPTER

AN ACT

Relating to child safety; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Department of Justice, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$6,000,000, for the Crime Victim and Survivor Services Division, for distribution to eligible children's advocacy centers under ORS 418.746 to 418.796.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> This 2023 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2023 Act takes effect on its passage.
