

# House Bill 2772

Sponsored by Representative EVANS; Representative GOMBERG (Pre-session filed.)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Creates crime of domestic terrorism. Punishes by maximum penalty of 10 years' imprisonment, \$250,000 fine, or both.

Relating to domestic terrorism.

**Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

**SECTION 1. (1) A person commits the crime of domestic terrorism if the person intentionally attempts to cause catastrophic harm.**

**(2) Domestic terrorism is a Class B felony.**

**(3) As used in this section, "catastrophic harm" means harm that:**

**(a) Results in extraordinary levels of death, injury, property damage or disruption of daily life; and**

**(b) Severely affects the population, infrastructure, environment, economy or government functioning of this state.**
