

House Bill 2803

Sponsored by Representative SOSA; Representatives NOSSE, REYNOLDS (at the request of Nicole Carr) (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Oregon Health Authority to study nutritionist licensing. Directs authority to submit findings to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to health care not later than September 15, 2024.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to nutritionists.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. The Oregon Health Authority shall study the establishment of a licensure**
5 **program for nutritionists, with a focus on ensuring that the licensure facilitates health**
6 **insurer reimbursement for services provided by nutritionists and increases access to pro-**
7 **fessional nutritional advice for Oregonians. The authority shall submit a report in the man-**
8 **ner provided by ORS 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation, to the interim**
9 **committees of the Legislative Assembly related to health care no later than September 15,**
10 **2024.**

11 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2023 Act is repealed on January 2, 2025.**
