

House Bill 2983

Sponsored by Representative MARSH; Representative FAHEY, Senator GOLDEN (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Department of Land Conservation and Development and Housing and Community Services Department to support manufactured dwellings and manufactured dwelling parks.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to manufactured dwellings.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, for the biennium**
5 **beginning July 1, 2023, out of the General Fund, there is appropriated:**

6 (1) **To the Housing and Community Services Department:**

7 (a) **\$35,000,000 for deposit in the Manufactured Home Preservation Fund under ORS**
8 **458.366 to be used to provide loans under ORS 458.352.**

9 (b) **\$10,000,000 to provide grants to qualified housing sponsors, as defined in ORS 456.548,**
10 **that are consumer housing cooperatives, nonprofit housing corporations or housing author-**
11 **ities, for the project costs of developing manufactured dwelling parks.**

12 (c) **\$10,000,000 to provide grants to a nonprofit corporation that is a community develop-**
13 **ment financial institution that operates statewide to support investment in the construction**
14 **of affordable housing, for the purpose of lending funds to construct or acquire manufactured**
15 **dwelling parks.**

16 (2) **To the Department of Land Conservation and Development, the amount of \$250,000**
17 **to develop:**

18 (a) **Model codes for the development of manufactured dwelling parks; and**

19 (b) **Efficiency measures for cottage clusters which may include the development of**
20 **manufactured dwellings as defined in ORS 458.356.**
